Parish Council Meetings

Acquisition of a Storage Extension for Kilham Hall and Multi Use Games Area (MUGA)

Work is due to start on the new brick built storage extension on Kilham Hall towards the end of August 2022. The MUGA specification has been agreed and the Parish Council's Architects are hoping to submit a planning application very shortly. In the meantime the Parish Council are applying for additional funding by way of a grant application to bridge the gap in funding due to increases costs due to COVID.

Acquisition of a New Defibrillator

The Parish Council applied for a grant via Doncaster Sheffield Airport Community Investment fund to be able to purchase a 2nd defibrillator for the parish. The Parish Council were informed that they were successful in their application and the funds would be released some time in the near future.
