#### **Parish Council Vacancy**

## **Volunteering Opportunities**

As part of the MUGA Consultation the Parish Council asked residents if they'd be interested in joining a friends of group within the Parish. A small number of residents expressed an interest in this so the Parish Council researched such a group. Unfortunately the Parish Council don't feel a friends of group would benefit the Parish as they tend to focus on things that are already in place ie. litter picking, organising events etc. However, the Parish Council have thought of ways they would appreciate Parishioners help within the Community ie. knitting/crocheting poppies for the Armistace Day Displays, watering plants around the Parish in the Summer months, joining the litter picking group quarterly and even consider becoming a Councillor when any vacancies occur. #### <u>Deer Crossing</u>

Last year the Parish Council raised concerns with DMBC regarding the number of deer crossing Doncaster Road and requested warning signs be placed on the bridge. There is a fairly widely held perception that the signs offer some form of protection to the deer, when of course that is not the case, the only purpose of the signs is to warn road users, and this implies a need to modify driving behaviour in order to account for the hazard. Therefore DMBC will continue to monitor the situation but currently will not be installing warning signs. Please drive safely and slowly through our villages and report any accidents with wildlife to DMBC via their website reporting tools.

A great day was had by all at the Open Hall event on 8<sup>th</sup> May for the King's Coronation. Cake, teas and coffees were flowing, a Coronation Quiz was held, there were arts and crafts for the children along with entertainment from Steve Love.

# **Lost Property**
