2019 Annual Parish Meeting on Wednesday 6 March 2019 at 6.30pm

2019/20 Precept - Annual Review from 1 April 2019

Following the issuing of revised information from DMBC the parish council determined that the 2019/20 precept should increase by an average of 1.56% (for a Band 'D' property). This provides for an increase to enable further developments for the benefit of the community as well as to cover the cost of inflation and to take account of the reduction of £408 in grant funding from DMBC the total revenue raised will be £40,000.

Outcome of Consultation on the Provision of a Multi Use Games Area (MUGA)

Thank you to the 60 parishioners who have taken the time to complete the consultation document which has provided useful information and denoted that over 75% were in favour of the provision of a MUGA. Arrangements will be made to hold a public consultation meeting at Kilham Hall later in the year when more details of the availability of the funding is known.
